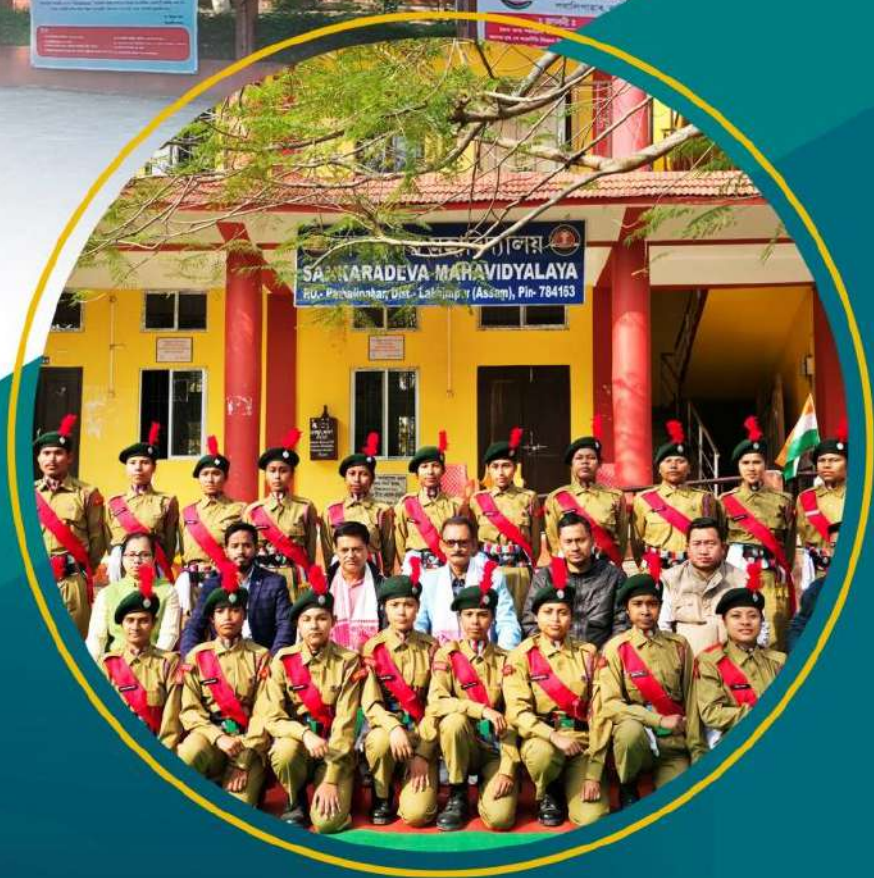

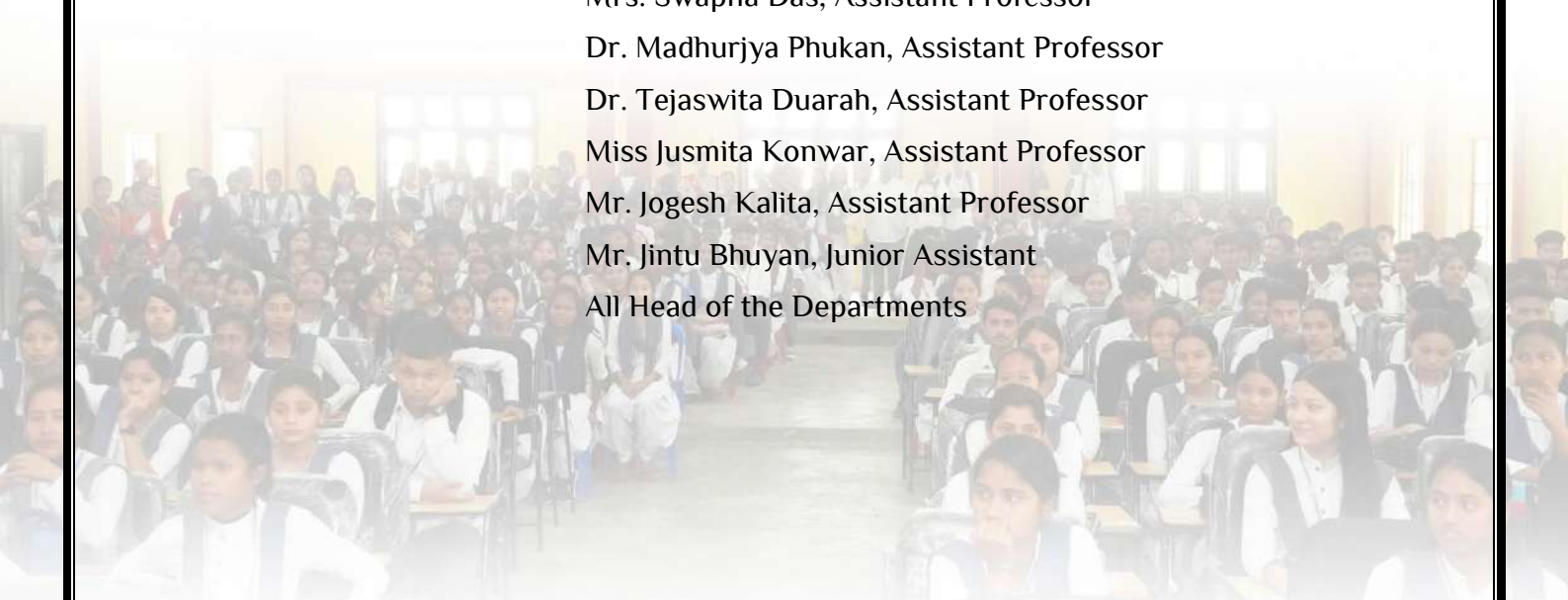

THE COLLEGE IN BRIEF

Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya was established at Pathalipahar under Narayanpur Revenue Circle, in Lakhimpur district of Assam on 5th September, 1982. The people of the greater locality unanimously decided to set up a higher educational institution in the area on the hill top bordering of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh. This place also has been merged under tribal sub-plan area with economic backwardness. Considering this bleak aspect and dreaming of a brighter prospect, the local inhabitants felt that this institution will create a new bridge of coordination between the two states, keeping all these view in mind "*Pathalipahar Anchalik Unnayan Sewa Samiti*" with the cooperation of eminent educationist of Lakhimpur district, organized a general meeting to establish this institution in the pious name of Mahapurush Sankaradeva the trend setter of Assamese nation.

ABOUT THE FOUR-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES (FYUGP) IN CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

Madhabdev University has introduced the Four-Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP) in Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) as per NEP-2020 guidelines from the academic session 2023 - 2024. The Four-Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP) in Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) will offer the Courses of Study leading to a UG Certificate, UG Diploma, Three Year UG Degree, Four Year UG Degree (Honours) and Four Year UG Degree (Honours with Research).

This Four-Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP) will provide a multidisciplinary set-up to build vibrant communities of scholars and peers, breakdown harmful silos, enable students to become well rounded across disciplines including artistic, creative, and analytical subjects as well as sports, develop active research communities across disciplines, increase resource efficiency across higher education.

This FYUGP will also provide a student centric, flexible, choice-based credit framework with multiple entry and exit options so that students can be facilitated to pursue the trail of career chosen by themselves as per their interest.

This Four-Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP) will include the following

- UG Certificate Programme :** UG Certificate Programme leads to a UG certificate after completing 1 year (2 semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study. Students on exit shall be awarded UG certificate (in the Field of Study/Discipline) after securing the requisite 40 Credits on completion of Semester II if, in addition, they complete one work based/skill based vocational course/internship of 4 credits within

one year from the completion of 2nd semester examination. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within a period of three years and complete the degree within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.

- (ii) **UG Diploma Programme** : UG Diploma Programme leads to a UG diploma after 2 years (4 semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study. Students on exit shall be awarded UG Diploma (in the Field of Study/Discipline) after securing the requisite 84 Credits on completion of Semester IV if, in addition, they complete one work based/skill based vocational course/internship of 4 credits within one year from the completion of 4th semester examination. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within a period of three years and complete the degree within the maximum period of seven years.
- (iii) **Three Year UG Degree Programme (BA, B. Sc, B. Com and Bachelors in other disciplines) with single/double major**: Students who wish to undergo a 3-year (6 semesters) UG programme shall be awarded UG degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing a minimum of 128 credits.
- (iv) **Four Year UG Programme with honours (BA, B. Sc, B. Com and Bachelors in other disciplines) with single/double major**: Students who wish to undergo a 4-year (8 semester) UG programme shall be awarded UG Honours degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of four years, securing a minimum of 174 credits.
- (v) **Four Year UG Programme with honours with Research (BA, B. Sc, B. Com and Bachelors in other disciplines) with major**: Students who wish to undergo a 4-year (8 semesters) UG programme shall be awarded UG Honours and research degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of four years with a rigorous research project, securing a minimum of 174 credits.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

How to apply

- Students seeking admission into B.A. (FYUGP) 1st semester will have to apply through the online admission portal of SAMARTH (Assam). Students can get all the relevant information regarding admission from the official website of Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya.
- Admission to the college will be made purely in order of merit and governed by the State Government Rules and College Admission Rules.
- For the admission process during online application and verification during admission cum interview time students must have the following documents:
 - a) Original Mark sheet of the last qualifying H.S. examination.
 - b) Original Pass certificate from the Board/ Council
 - c) Birth Certificate/ Admit Card of HSLC Exam
 - d) Caste Certificate from the competent authority (for OBC/MOBC/ ST/ SC/PwD candidates)
 - e) Gap certificate from the last attended institution (if required)
 - f) Annual Income Certificate for BPL candidate.

Minimum eligibility criteria for multiple entry points of the UG programmes

- **1st year:** Senior Secondary School Leaving Certificate or Higher Secondary (Class 12) Certificate obtained after successful completion of Grade 12 or equivalent stage of education and/or Admission test conducted by College/University/National Level Testing Agency/State Level Testing Agency.
- **2nd year:** A certificate obtained after successful completion of 1 year (2 semesters) of the undergraduate programme. These students are to take admission in the 2nd year within a period of three years from obtaining the UG certificate from Madhabdev University or any other University/institution recognized by Madhabdev University.
- **3rd year :** A diploma obtained after successful completion of 2 years (4 semesters) of the undergraduate programme. These students are to take admission in the 3rd year UG programme within a period of three years from obtaining the UG diploma from Madhabdev University or any other University/institution recognized by Madhabdev University.
- **4th Year (Honours) :** A Bachelor's degree after successful completion of three years (6 semesters) of the Undergraduate programme obtained from Madhabdev University or any other University/institution recognized by Madhabdev University. These students are to complete the degree within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.
- **4th Year (Honours with Research):** A three-year Bachelor Degree with a minimum of 7.5 CGPA. The minimum entry requirement for 4th year (Honours/Research) UG programme within a period of three years from obtaining 3-year Bachelor Degree from Madhabdev University or any other University/institution recognized by Madhabdev University. These students are to complete the degree within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.

Selection Procedure

- Eligible candidates are selected for admission into B.A. Programme strictly on merit basis subjected to the approval of the Admission Committee of the college. The Admission Committee will verify and scrutinizes the Admission Forms and prepared a merit list of the selected candidates and it will be uploaded at the college website and displayed on the college notice board prior to the interview cum admission process.
- During selection process, the college will follow the reservation policy for SC (7.5 %), ST (P) (10 %), ST (H) (5 %), OBC/ MOBC (27%), PwD (4 %) as per the Govt. of Assam Rules. In addition 5 % of total seats is reserved for students having proficiency in sports, NSS, NCC, Scouts and Guides and Cultural activities.

SANKARADEVA STUDY CENTRE

The Sankardeva Study Centre is initiating academic activities on the various aspects of the great saint of Assam Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankardeva. The Centre deals with study and research activities on contributions of Sankardeva in the field of literature, dance, drama, music, painting and other areas.

Presently it has a good collection of books a part from age-old manuscripts, thesis, papers etc.

LABORATORY

The Department of Education and Geography has a laboratory for conducting practical classes.

ICT FACILITY

In addition to general class rooms, the institution has a well-equipped digital conference hall for seminar, workshop etc. The college has also well-equipped digital class rooms with ICT facility in the department of Geography, Political Science, Economics and Education.

HOSTEL

The college offers hostel accommodation for girls only. The college has well equipped hostel facility for girl's student. The numbers of seats are limited. Application form for hostel admission can be obtained from college office. Admission to hostel will be made based on availability of seats and on the basis of percentage of marks. NSS

NCC

The National Cadet Corps is the Indian military cadet corps which open to college students on voluntary basis. Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya is equipped with the 63 Assam Bn NCC Dibrugarh Unit with a sanction of 108 cadets, wherein the Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades.

Excursion/Field Works

Besides departmental compulsory excursion the institution arranges Educational Excursions and Field Works for students. The Excursion team accompanied by teacher in charge gets an opportunity to see and interact with people from different regions and states.

Shooting Range

The Shooting Range was established in 2013, funded by UGC. It is the second Range in Assam as well as the only one in the entire higher educational institution in North East India. The measurement of the Range is 100ft x 36 sq. ft and centrally air conditioned, having 7 shooting lane for Pistols and Rifles shooting. The Range is affiliated to Assam Rifles Shooting Association (ARSA), Guwahati, Assam. Every year the Range conducts District level shooting competition in the month of Sept to Oct. The intake capacity is restricted to 20 shooters per shift. International Shooter Hriday Hazarika, Narayanpur started his career at our shooting range. He has won gold medal at the 10th Asian Air Gun Championship which was held in Wako Tokyo, Japan. Interested students can join and start his career here. The administration of Shooting Range is carried out by two Range Officer.

Gymnasium

The college has a modern gymnasium for the use of students furnished with modern fitness equipment's. It helps the students to maintain their physical fitness.


