Observation of National Voters Day

40th College week (5th to 10th February, 2024)

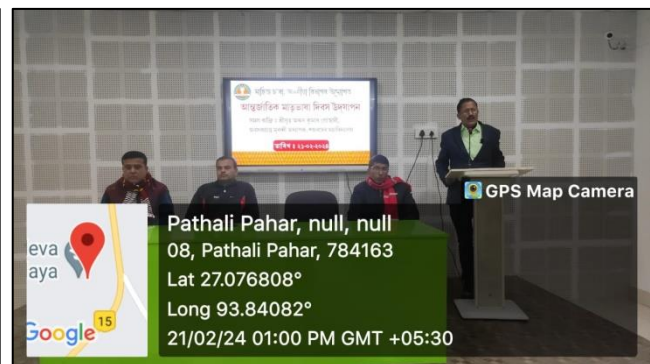

One Day International Workshop on The Elements of Weather and Climate

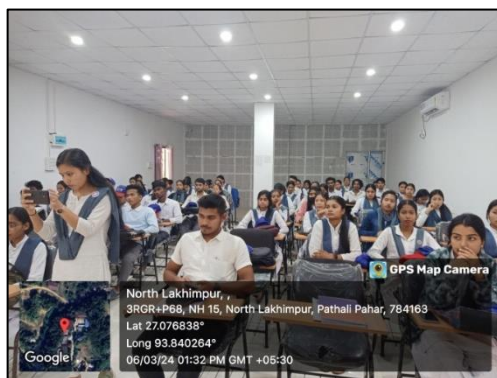

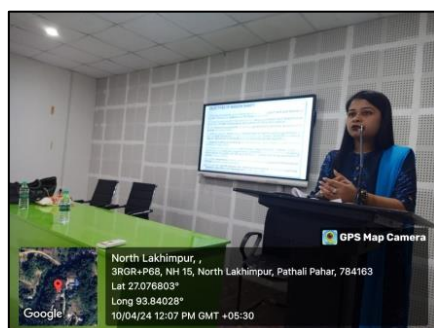
Cleanliness Drive

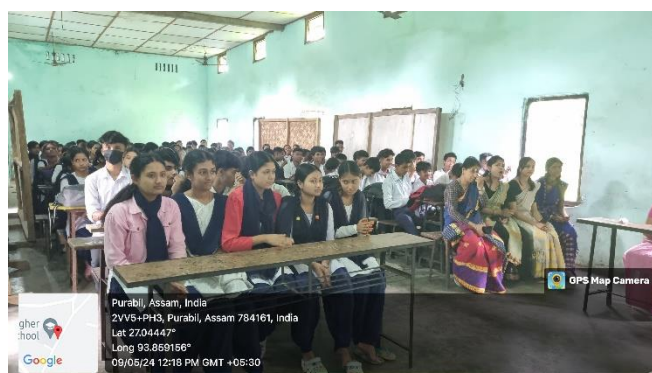
Career Counseling Programme at Simaluguri Higher Secondary School and Rangati Higher Secondary School

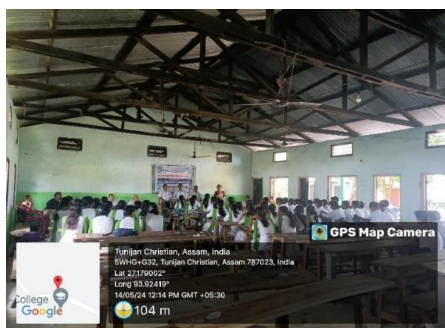
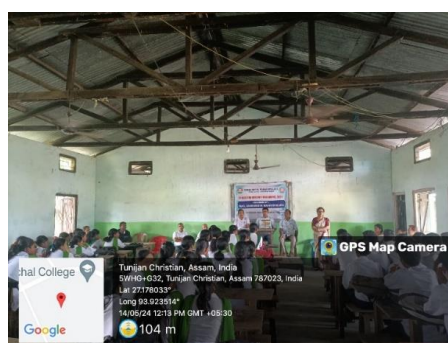
Career Counseling Programme at Harmoti Higher Secondary School

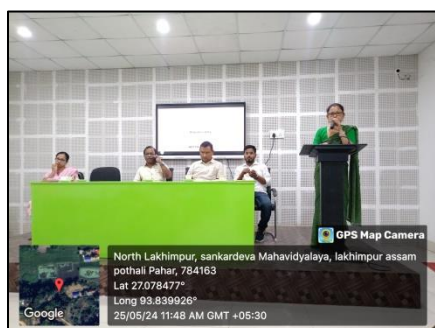
One Day National Workshop on NEP 2020- Prospects and Challenges

National Librarians' Day

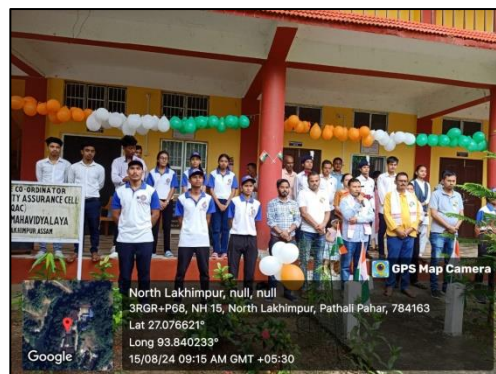

flexibility, accessibility, and potential for lifelong learning, allowing individuals to pursue academic goals despite geographical or time constraints.



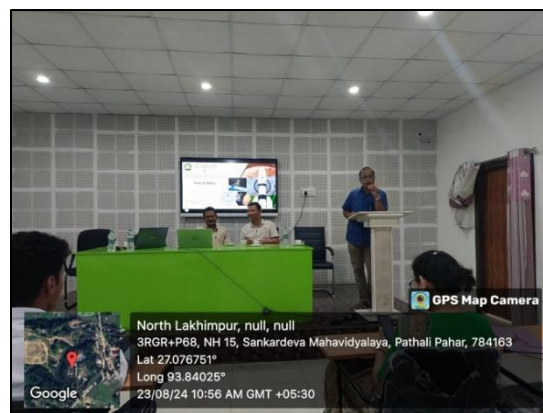
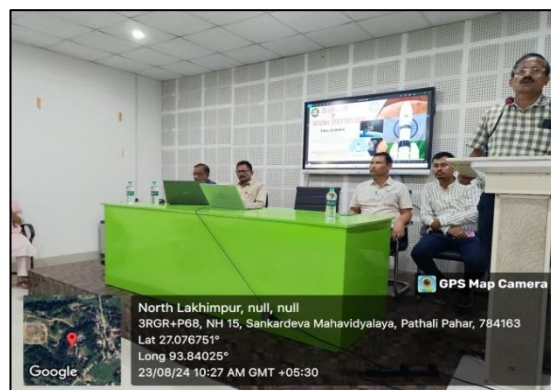
Career Counselling Programme on Career in Information Technology and How it works

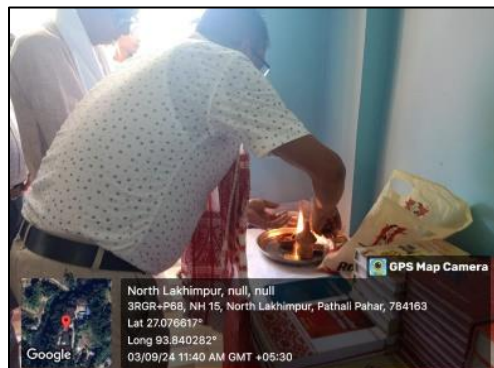
2nd Parent Teacher Meeting of Department of Geography

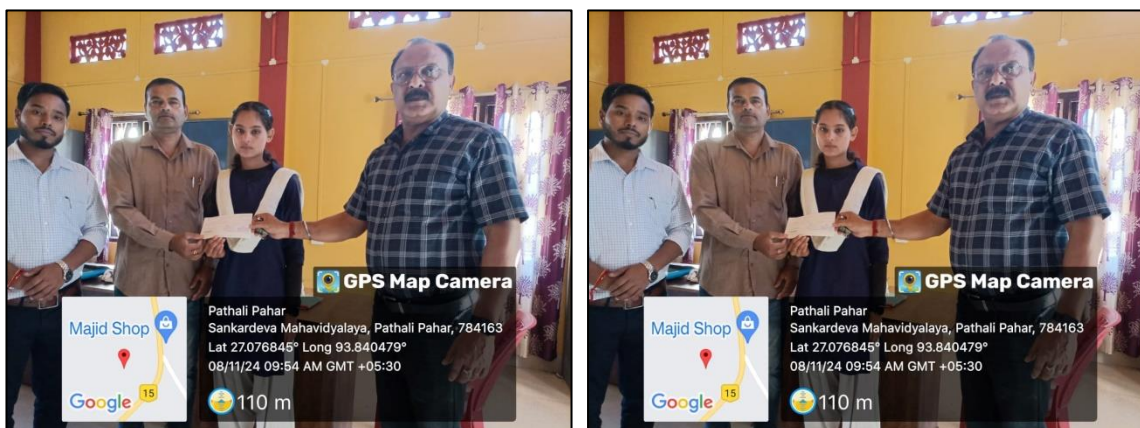
Oath taking Ceremony and Magazine Inauguration

Participation in Bihpuria LAC Level Khel Maharan 2.0

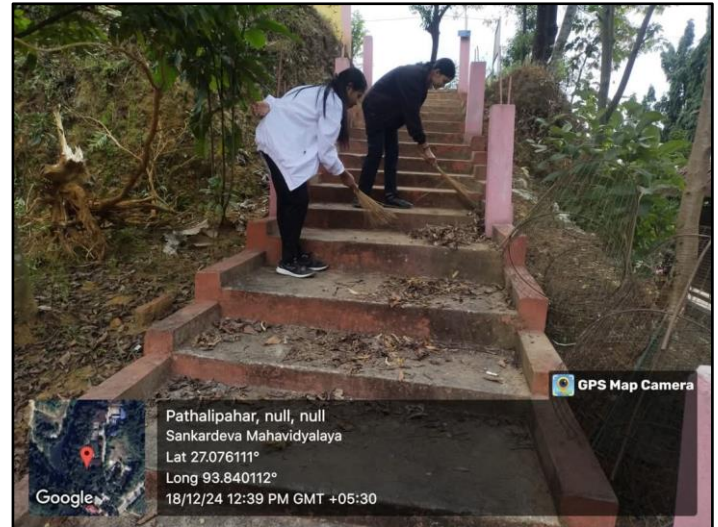
