## **Feedback Analysis Report for the Session 2022-23**

The institution recently conducted an online feedback survey for the academic session 2022-23, encompassing responses from 141 students across all departments and semesters. The insights derived from the feedback shed light on various facets of the students' experiences. The college prospectus garnered mixed reviews, with only a minimal percentage deeming it very poor. A substantial majority, comprising 53.2% of students, regarded it as good. The admission procedure emerged as a point of satisfaction, as a large majority expressed contentment, while a mere 2.2% found it lacking. In terms of the teaching-learning process, the feedback indicated a positive environment, with the majority praising the cooperation of teachers. However, a limited number of students expressed dissatisfaction in this regard. The cooperation of office staff and the Students' Union received widespread acclaim, showcasing positive interactions between these entities and the student body. Student welfare activities, encompassing financial assistance and remedial classes, generally earned positive feedback, although a minority of students reported a less favourable experience. Administrative support in co-curricular activities, including NSS, sports, music, and culture, was recognized as effective. In terms of facilities, basic classroom amenities received favourable reviews from nearly half of the students. The presence of modern teaching aids, such as ICT tools, was acknowledged positively by 51.1% of respondents. Regarding academic resources, a majority of students found the syllabus (57.4%) and the availability of textbooks (45.4%) to be satisfactory. Infrastructure and campus environment assessments yielded positive results. Over half of the students expressed satisfaction with campus cleanliness, lighting, ventilation, and overall maintenance. Specific facilities, including the library reading room, digital classrooms, auditorium, canteen, and sports facilities, garnered favourable responses from the majority. The analysis also delved into gender-specific facilities, revealing varying satisfaction levels in the common rooms, with a higher percentage of contentment in the girls' common room compared to the boys'.

In conclusion, the feedback paints a generally positive picture of the institution, highlighting areas of satisfaction and providing valuable insights into potential areas for improvement. The majority of students expressed contentment with the overall educational experience, institutional facilities, and support services.

The college has collected feedback from its faculty members. The feedback form was prepared by the IQAC and the criteria coordinator, considering all curricular and extracurricular indicators. The collected data were compiled and analyzed using pie charts for each indicator. From the data, it was found that most faculty members chose the "Agree" option from the 5th grading point. Both the syllabus and course content were agreed upon by 76% of the faculty members. Similarly, for most indicators, the majority of faculty responded positively. However, there is still room for improvement in certain areas, such as the availability of reference books for faculty, with 53% responding as "Neutral."

Conclusion: In conclusion, we can say that while the overall environment of the college shows a good performance, there is still ample opportunity to enhance the college for the greater benefit of both students and faculty.
