



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)



### GENERAL AGREEMENT Of Academic, Extension and Consultancy

Between

Department of Political Science, Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya Pathalipahar,  
Lakhimpur, Assam

And

Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (Autonomous),  
Lakhimpur, Assam

#### Introduction

This Memorandum of understanding (MoU) is executed on this day of 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 between Department of Political Science, Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya, Pathalipahar, Lakhimpur as the First party and Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (A), Lakhimpur- as the Second party; herein together referred to as, the Institutions.

#### About the Institutions

Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya, Pathalipahar have its campus at Pathalipahar, Lakhimpur. It stands high with its virtues of excellence and a contribution- to the society at large. It offers a unique educational experience that prepares the next generation of global citizens to lead and make a difference in the world. With its talented and motivated student-body and accomplished faculty, Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya is a leading educational hub in the border of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh and it tries to maintain a particular commitment to exceptional undergraduate instructions and aims to be the best college of the region. The college is doing its level best to achieve the goal of the College. The vision of the college is to produce at least one graduate from each family from the catchment area of the college.

And

North Lakhimpur College (A), Lakhimpur is a foremost institution offering Arts, Science courses under its own Jurisdiction as it is an Autonomous College. The college is well equipped with modern infrastructural facilities and backed by an excellent and dedicated faculty to cater to the needs and aspirations of the students to meet the challenges of the present day competitive world. Apart from academic pursuits, stress is laid on co-curricular activities and all round development of the student's personality. North Lakhimpur College has proved to have the strategy to percolate the positive outcome of the innovations in teaching with an interdisciplinary approach. The gradual reform has made the college holistically efficient and credible both at the academic and administrative level. The college strongly believes that its primary stake holders are students. It also understands the geographic, socio-demographic, economic and educational background of the people of this region. The college intends to provide quality education to all keeping in view the intelligence and economic status of the students. The vision of the college is Equitable, accessible and value-based education for holistic development.

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## Duties and Responsibilities of both the Institute

Whereas Department of Political Science, Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya has requested Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (A) to collaborate to achieve its objectives, through various programmes for the academic promotion with the following identified but not limited to,

1. **Faculty Exchange Programme** – Faculty members of the Department of Political Science, Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya may take a lecture or a series of lectures at the Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (A) as Resource Persons for portions or special topics of a few identified courses in consultation with the North Lakhimpur College (A) and vice versa- at a mutually convenient timing, during the session.
2. **Student Exchange Programme** – Students of the Department of Political Science, Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya could attend class or a series of lectures provided by the Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (A). Similarly, students of the Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (A) may attend class at Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya.
3. **Joint organization of Seminar/ workshop** may be jointly organized by the faculties of Department of Political Science, Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya and faculties of the Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (A).
4. **Joint Publication** – Both the Departments of the institute may publish joint academic works on the subject domain.
5. **Extension Activities** – Both the parties agreed upon collaborate with each other in different extension programmes. In this regard decision will be taken only after a mutual discussion between the institutions.

Both Department of Political Science, Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya and Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (A) agreed that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this MoU will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose, covered by this MoU, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information-disclosing party and entered public domain.

Subject to clauses below, both the Institutions may attend this MoU by mutual consent in writing. Any amendment agreed by the Institutions shall come into effect from the date determined by the signing institutions on potential areas.

This MoU shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years. Thereafter, the Institutions and its department, namely Department of Political Science, Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya and Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (A), shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this MoU. However, Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (A) has freedom to continue or discontinue the MoU at its own discretion.

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In any other circumstance, or other detailed collaboration between the two parties, a separate MoU shall be drawn up as and when required.

The Institutions, that is Department of Political Science, Sankardeva Mahavidyalaya and Department of Political Science, North Lakhimpur College (A), agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the basis of goodwill and shall not be legally bound. Nothing mentioned in this MoU shall deem constitute partnership between the signing institutions appointing one party as an agent of the other. This MoU will be effective upon signature by both the Principal of the college for a period of three years, at which time it will be reviewed for possible renewal for further period of three years. Either party may, on three (3) months' notice in writing, terminate the MoU in advance of its normal expiration or request the recognition of its conditions.
