The increasing frequency of climate-related disasters further intensifies vulnerabilities in the region. The growing tension between development and environmental sustainability raises critical concerns about environmental justice, democratic governance, and the protection of constitutional and human rights.

The seminar on “Environment and Human Rights in North East India: Issues and Prospects” aims to critically examine the interconnectedness between ecological concerns and human rights in the region. The seminar will provide an academic and policy-oriented platform to discuss pressing environmental challenges, legal frameworks, community participation, climate resilience, and sustainable development strategies by bringing together scholars, policymakers, activists, researchers, legal experts, civil society organizations, and community representatives.
